373 Average Daily Departures to 98 Nonstop Destinations

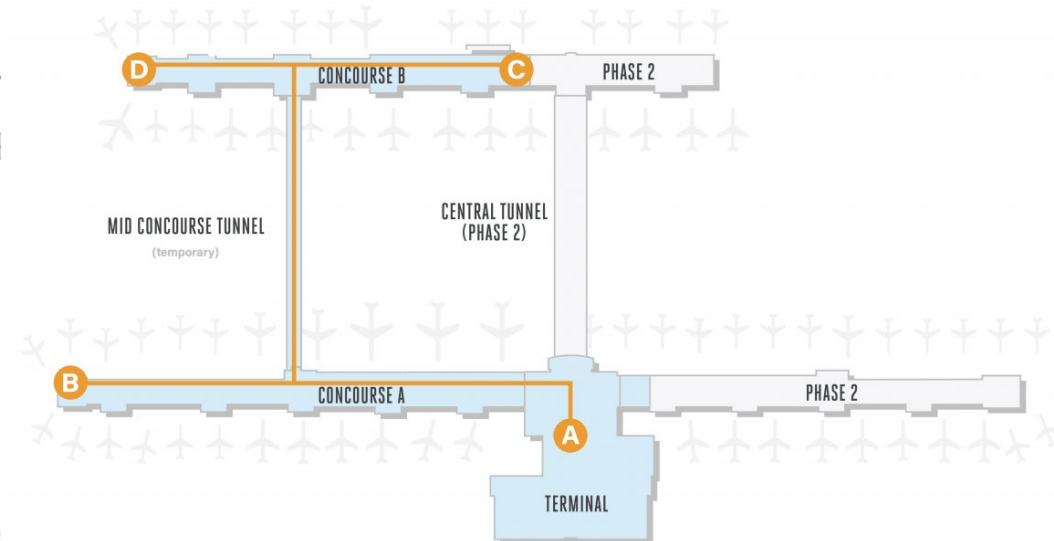


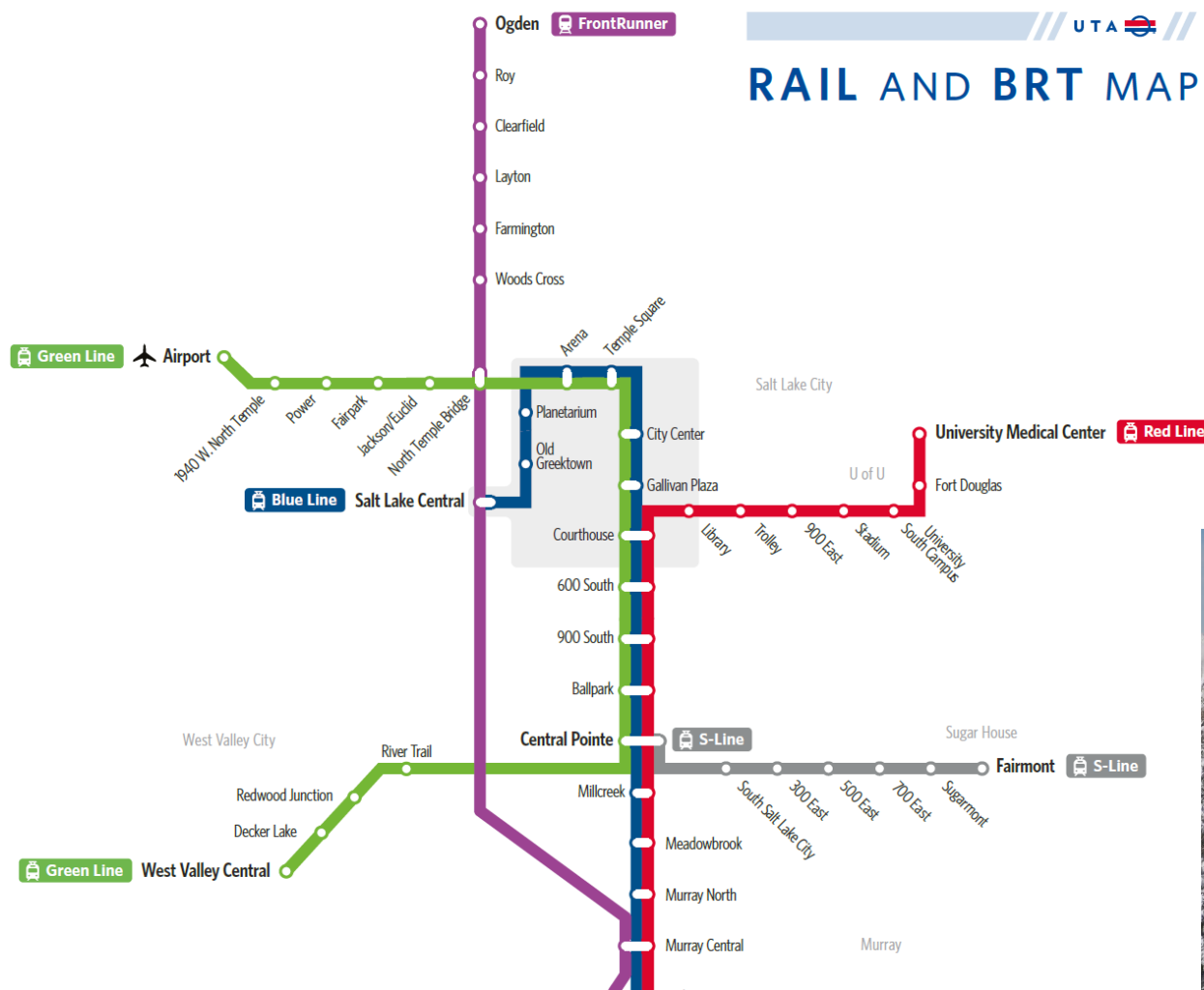
Getting there
